# Ovar House Ovar, Portugal

This luxurious family home is located just inland from the northern stretches of Portugal's Atlantic Ocean coastline. The house is situated in the centre of its large triangular suburban plot, making the most of existing and new landscape elements to screen it from its neighbours.

The building, a long rectangular prism, takes advantage of the natural slope of the site so that to the front of the house both storeys rise out of the ground and overlook the pool terrace, whereas at the rear, where the site is higher, only the upper level and a strip of ribbon windows below are exposed, giving the house a lower profile. A moat-like reflecting pool surrounds the house, giving it


the appearance of floating in a shallow lake.

On the ground floor are all of the living spaces including the kitchen, dining and living spaces, as well as recreation facilities including a play room, billiards room and an indoor swimming pool that occupies a slender rectangular volume arranged perpendicular to the main house.

The upper level is accessed via a central staircase where a corridor leads to four bedrooms, all with dressing rooms and ensuite bathrooms. To one end of the space, a gallery overlooks the kitchen and dining room below, while at the other, a dramatic terrace over the pool, accessed from the master bedroom, enjoys views across the landscape.

The master bathroom consists of a large, white-tiled open space housing the double vanity bench and a free-standing bathtub, with a separate raised area to house the WC and shower. These two more private spaces are divided by a wall of polished Negro Marquina black marble. The pure white walls, floor, ceiling and fixtures are relieved by accents of dark timber joinery and lit by a recessed skylight in the ceiling above the bathtub.

The landscaped grounds include various games courts supported by a separate outbuilding. The master bedroom suite (top right) has direct access to the large terrace over the swimming pool, with its cutaway timber-clad balustrade walls.




